

EQUINOX COWL



Project: This cowl is knit in the round using the fun-to-learn **Mosaic** colorwork technique. You can make 2 for the price of one using a skein each of a light and dark color – how about one for you and one for a Holiday gift!

Taught by: Liz Little

Description: 3 x 2hour classes

Cost: \$75 plus supplies

Dates: Sunday, September 4th, 3-5pm
Sunday, September 18th, 3-5pm
Sunday, October 2nd, 3-5pm

Skills needed: Confident beginner, keen to learn a fun colorwork technique!

Skills learned: We will make Cowl #1 in class. (Cowl #2 uses same techniques and different needle sizes).

- Working in the round in stockinette and seed stitch
- Joining-in new color
- Slipping stitches with contrast color in back
- Carrying yarn up the sides
- Stretchy bind-off options
- Finishing techniques

Materials needed:

- 2 contrasting skeins of Worsted weight yarn – shop sample uses Malabrigo Rios.
- US9/5.5mm, 24” circular needles (or size needed to obtain Cowl #1 gauge of 19 stitches x 25 rounds per 4”).
- 3 stitch markers + 1 Beginning of round (BOR) marker
- Tapestry needle
