

BUILDING WITH LACE - A SERIES OF 10 (4-WEEKLY) CLASSES

- Project: Lace-work sampler stole
- Taught by: Liz Little
- Description: 10 x 2 hour classes, held every 4 weeks
- Cost: \$190, not including materials
- 2022 Dates: Sunday, October 16th, 1-3pm
Sunday, November 13th, 1-3pm
Sunday, December 11th, 1-3pm
Classes will continue in 2023 on a 4-weekly basis
- Skills Needed: Knitting basics – and a desire for a new challenge!
- Skills Learned: progressive lace knitting techniques will include:
- Extensive lace chart reading
 - double yarn overs
 - lace and cables
 - beads
 - smocking
 - circular designs
 - nupps
 - pattern both sides
 - applied borders

Materials needed:

- 5 x 100grams of **Sport** weight yarn. The stole is knit at quite an open gauge of 22 stitches and 29 rows for a 4" stockinette square. Choose a fiber that will give some drape, eg. yarn that includes some alpaca or silk content.

- US 6/4mm Lace tipped 32" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- US F/4mm crochet hook used in provisional cast on
- Optional No. 6 seed beads (used in Section #5 and borders, if desired).
- Optional US 12/0.75mm crochet hook for bead placement
- OTHER TOOLS: stitch markers, cable needle, fix-it tool, row-counter, highlighter tape, tapestry needle, 20 yards smooth contrast color waste cast on yarn, 1 yard smooth contrast color yarn for lifeline

PREPARATION:

- Read the General Information section of the Building with Lace book, pages 4 to 7.
- Complete a washed and blocked gauge swatch and bring it to first class. Twisted Knitter will be pleased to assist you with any questions.
- Bring wound project yarn, needles and tools to the first class.
- If desired, bring smooth, light colored worsted weight yarn and appropriate size needles to practice the Section 1 lace stitches.
