

Everyone needs a Gnome Stocking!!!



**Skills Needed:**

Basic knitting skills.

**Skills Learned:**

Intarsia, working from a chart, stranded knitting, mattress and kitchener stitches, i-cord, using bobbins for colorwork and weaving in ends from intarsia strands.

**Materials Needed:**

- Worsted weight yarn in colors of choice.
- Pattern calls for 1 - 16" US size 6 (4 mm) and 1 - 16" size 8 (5mm). Tina used sizes 6 and 7 to get the desired fabric density for the stocking. There is no gauge listed in the pattern. If you are a loose knitter you may want to go down to a size 5 and 7 needle.
- Tapestry needle
- Bobbins
- Stitch Markers

**Preparation:**

Pre-purchase yarn, supplies, pattern and knit a swatch in the larger needles over 30 stitches.
