Skills Needed:

Basic knitting skills, working in the round.

Skills Learned:

- Ladder back jacquard knitting
- Reading a chart in the round
- Knitting in the round on 2 circular needles
- Jogless stripe

Materials Needed:

- DK weight yarn (equivalent to Berroco Vintage DK) in 3 colors (you will be able to make multiple hats from the 3 skeins).
- Darning needle

- 1 - US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 16 inch circular needle, and 2- US Size 6 (4 mm) 16 inch circular needles.
- stitch markers.

Preparation:

Pre-purchase yarn and needles and swatch for gauge. (Gauge should be 22 sts and 28 rows over 4 inches in stockinette on the larger needles – notice the pattern doesn't specify gauge – it is only listed on Ravelry and the gauge is different from what I am telling you – we will discuss this issue in class – oh the mystery!)

Once you have gauge, work the pattern through the Fold-over brim section. Do not knit the first row of the body. Bring it on in and let's have some fun!

As always, if you can't get gauge, bring it to the shop and let us help you figure out what to do.
